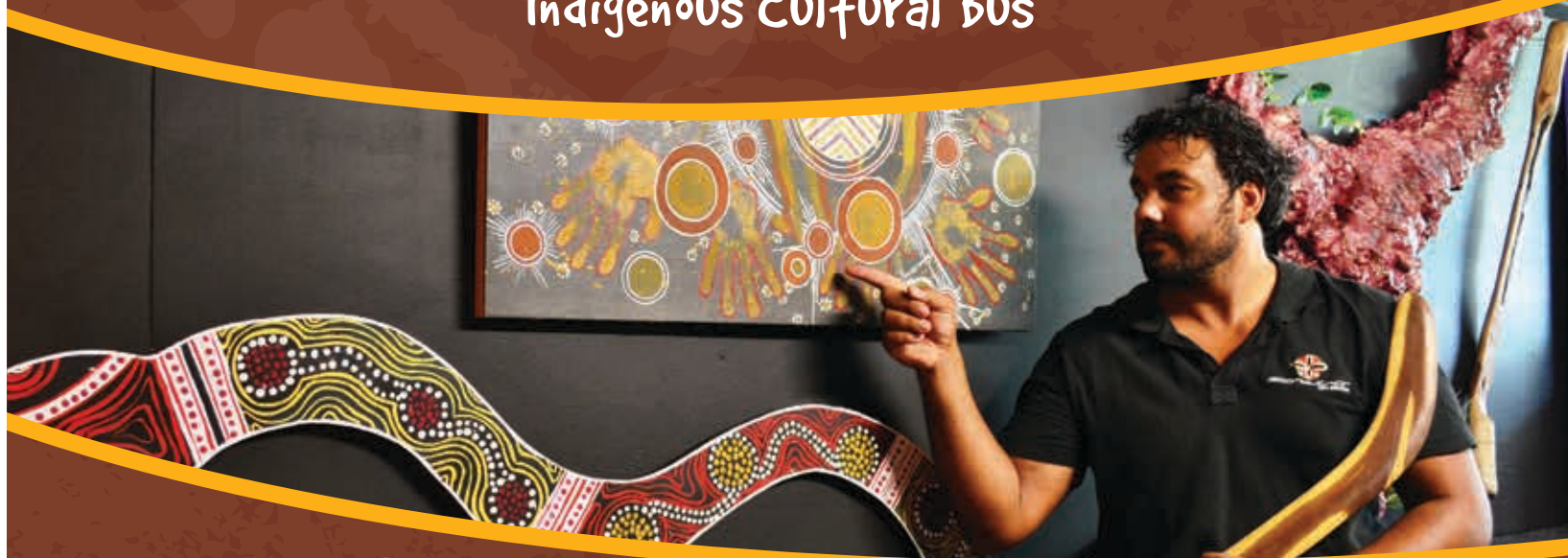




GOOMBUCKAR

What it is...

A 34 seater bus converted into a mobile Indigenous learning platform. A living history & story telling experience, that the students will enjoy coming aboard & learning about our local Indigenous places, people, culture & stories.

How it works...

Each class will do 2 or more activities with us. 1 cultural lesson inside the bus and 1 art & symbol lesson outside. We run 2 classes per session with 2 facilitators. All our class lessons are different and related to each year curriculum links.

- ☉ Full day or weekly visit with multiple year levels (so everyone can experience Culture first-hand).
- ☉ Workshops, from prep to 7 all having curriculum linked lessons.
